Note: ¹ Resident rate applies only to residents of York Township. To qualify you must be a York Township property owner or a dependent of a York Township property owner.

² Foundations are 30” deep and have a 4” extension added to the length and width unless specified otherwise. Foundation orders must be placed by May 1st to meet the spring deadline & September 15th for the fall deadline. Invoices will be sent when foundations are complete. They will be payable upon receipt. *Price increased January 1, 2015.

³ Grave lots are to be paid in full at the time of deed application.

⁴ Opening & closing fees to be paid upon receipt of burial transit.

⁵ Cremations must be in a concrete vault or marble urn. Two (2) cremations per burial lot are allowed.

⁶ Transfer fees apply when a deed owner is requesting York Township to transfer their ownership over to another person.

Cemetery crews will clean up the cemeteries twice a year: April 15th and October 15th. All old mementos or wreaths will be removed at that time. Residents are urged to remove items before cleaning dates if it is something they want to keep.

York Township will buy back cemetery plots that have been sold at the rate of 25% of the purchase price from any person who wants to sell them back to the township. A \$25 processing fee will be applied for each burial being bought back (resident or non-resident). The processing fee will be deducted from the price of the plots that will be paid to the person wanting to sell their plots back to the township.
